"ONE HEART, ONE SOUL CAMPAIGN"

The early returns in the, "One Heart, One Soul" Campaign are promising! Through mid May 14 Pilot Wave Parishes have raised a total of more than \$2.5 million and an additional \$1.6 million has been pledged by other diocesan supporters and organizations. That total is about 12 percent of the campaign's \$35 million goal. The Pilot Wave will run through June and three larger additional waves will follow as the campaign gathers steam and continues through early 2021. More than 30 parishes and a number of mission churches are taking part in the next wave and preparations at those parishes are under way. Kickoff weekend is tentatively set for September. Pastors at those parishes gathered on May 15th for a lunch at which the Pilot Wave pastors shared their experiences. The campaign is aimed at strengthening parishes and several diocesan wide ministries.
