FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION - AUGUST 15th

Thursday, August 15th is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, one of the most important Marian feasts of the Church year. Given that our church is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary it is only fitting that Marian Feast Days be celebrated with greater solemnity here at the Basilica. You are encouraged to come and give thanks to God for the great gift of His Blessed Mother that He has given to His people. Mass will be celebrated at 7:00p.m. All are welcome.

TWO MARIAN FEAST DAYS ON AUGUST 22nd

Thursday, August 22nd is the Feast of the Queenship of Mary in the current liturgical calendar, but in the older calendar it is the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary (in the current calendar the Feast of the Immaculate Heart was missed this year). The regular Parish Mass for the Queenship of Mary will be celebrated at 7:30a.m. However in the evening there will be a Solemn High Mass in the Extraordinary Form at 7:00p.m. You are very welcome to attend and experience an older and venerable form of Catholic worship.
