## FRATELLI TUTTI: ENCYCLICAL LETTER OF POPE FRANCIS

On Sunday, October 4<sup>th</sup>, 2020, Pope Francis published his third encyclical letter, Fratelli Tutti (Brothers and Sisters All). It is a call to disrupt our lives and pay attention to the world. The Holy Father wanted to recognize the inspiration he drew from St. Francis; he urges us to dream together, and dispel the dark clouds of conflicts, suffering and conformism. The encyclical is divided into eight chapters, beginning with "dark clouds cover the world" and ending off with "religion and fraternity". Pope Francis intends this encyclical to be accessible and read by all persons and especially for those who wish to build a more just and fraternal world in their ordinary relationships, in social life, politics and institutions. An informative five-minute video gives the themes of the 45,000 word letter, Fratelli Tutti, and is available on YouTube.
