Thank you very much to all of you who have supported our **One Heart One Soul Campaign**. As you know this major fundraising campaign throughout the Diocese supports our parish, parishes in need, and Diocesan ministries including University Campus Ministries, Prison Ministry, Hospital Chaplaincy, and Ministry of Migrant Workers. As of May 20, we had 224 gifts totalling \$783,236.00. This exceeds our minimum, or "Celebration" goal, and puts us well on the way to achieving our "Challenge" goal of \$825,000.00. 36 percent of our parish households have participated thus far.
