Following the announcement from the Government of Ontario regarding the opening of the Province from lockdown restrictions, I am very pleased to announce that the Basilica of Our Lady Immaculate will open again for public worship on Friday, June 11, the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Thank you very much to all of you who have supported our **One Heart One Soul Campaign**. As you know this major fundraising campaign throughout the Diocese supports our parish, parishes in need, and Diocesan ministries including University Campus Ministries, Prison Ministry, Hospital Chaplaincy, and Ministry of Migrant Workers. As of May 20, we had 224 gifts totalling \$783,236.00. This exceeds our minimum, or "Celebration" goal, and puts us well on the way

This person in this role will be responsible for the day to day running of the Weather Station, a program that gives safe space out of the elements to those who struggle with housing.

They will work with staff and volunteers to make sure all Covid protocols are being kept, and that the space is kept up to Public Health guidelines.

Other responsibilities will include:

- Stocking the Pantry
- Picking up supplies
- Food prep
- Food packaging
- Some cleaning
- Making sure there are emergency supplies - sleeping bags, blankets etc.
- Other tasks as needed
