Kindergarten Registration at Wellington Catholic DSB

The Wellington Catholic District School Board will be accepting new registrations for kindergarten at our schools beginning January 6, 2025!

To be eligible for registering in kindergarten, children;

- Must be four years of age on or before December 31, 2025, to attend Year 1 Kindergarten
- Must be five years of age on or before December 31, 2025, to attend Year 2 Kindergarten

To register we ask that you visit;

<u>https://www.wellingtoncdsb.ca/registration/kindergarten_registration</u> and complete the online student pre-registration form. Once you have completed this form you will receive a follow-up email to complete the registration process. We ask that you have the following documents available:

- Child's Birth Certificate
- Parent or Child's Baptismal Certificate
- Proof of Tax Support for Families New to the System (ie, Most Recent Tax Bill)
- Proof of Address (Government Document, Mortgage or Rental Agreement, Hydro Bill, Credit Card Statement)
- Immigration Documentation (If Applicable)
- Custody Documents (if Applicable)

During the registration process, school administration are available to assist you with any questions you may have.

Please note:

- Students currently attending a Wellington Catholic Year 1 Kindergarten program are <u>NOT</u> <u>REQUIRED</u> to register for Year 2 Kindergarten
- Should you have any questions about registration procedures or requirements, please contact your local Catholic school.
